



LEITH FESTIVAL 2019 AT EASTER ROAD STADIUM ON SUNDAY 16 JUNE (1PM TO 5PM)

The Hibernian Historical Trust in partnership with Hibernian Football Club is again pleased to welcome supporters and friends to the annual Open Day at Easter Road Stadium as part of the Leith Festival. We also welcome partner organisations who are taking part.

To assist visitors we have devised a self-guided route for your tour of the stadium. Locations along the route are clearly marked. There will also be stewards at key points to whom you can ask questions and seek assistance if required. For disabled visitors and others requiring assistance with access, there is provision along the tour route.

1. **START** by entering **STAIR 2** (marked the Clubhouse) left of the reception in the **WEST STAND**
2. Go upstairs to the first level and through on the left to the **PROGRAMME CORRIDOR**
3. At the end of the corridor turn left and visit the **CLUBHOUSE**
4. Retrace your steps and go through to the **GALLERY** to view the displays including a new Scottish Cup “dressing room” presentation
5. Go through the doors at the far end and along the corridor to the **PRESS ROOM**
6. On leaving turn left into the **CAPTAINS LOUNGE**
7. Do not go back into the Gallery but take the staircase (marked) up to the **DIRECTORS SUITE**
8. Visit the **DIRECTORS BOX** for a great view of the football stadium
9. Leave the Directors Suite by the end door and come down the main staircase to the **RECEPTION AREA** on the ground level and view the **HALL OF FAME** display
10. Go through to the **HOME DRESSING ROOM** viewing the away dressing room on the way
11. View the Managers Room before going through to the **WARM UP AREA**
12. Leave the warm up area and cross the passageway into the corridor on the right to view the **MATCH OFFICIALS AND INTERVIEW ROOMS**
13. Go up the **PLAYERS TUNNEL** to pitch side and the **HOME AND AWAY DUGOUTS**
****PLEASE DO NOT GO ONTO THE PITCH – UNDER PREPARATION FOR NEXT SEASON****
14. Turn right and walk around the pitch to the **EAST STAND** where you can view the **MEMORIAL WALL**
15. Leave the East Stand and go through to the **FAMOUS FIVE STAND CONCOURSE**

In the Concourse, as part of the tour Hibernian Football Club are creating a **KIDS ZONE** with various activities. The **CUP TROPHIES** won by Hibernian Ladies will also be on display.

This is the end of the tour. **EXIT** the stadium via the **CLUB SHOP**.
